

CERTIFICATE IN EUROPEAN STUDIES

The certificate may be earned simultaneously with a BA or BS degree, or post-baccalaureate. Requirements for the Certificate in European Studies include:

Two years of one adviser-approved foreign language or equivalent proficiency. Currently PSU offers courses in Danish, French, German, Italian, Russian, Spanish. Occasionally other European Languages are offered through special heritage or summer programs.	(24)
